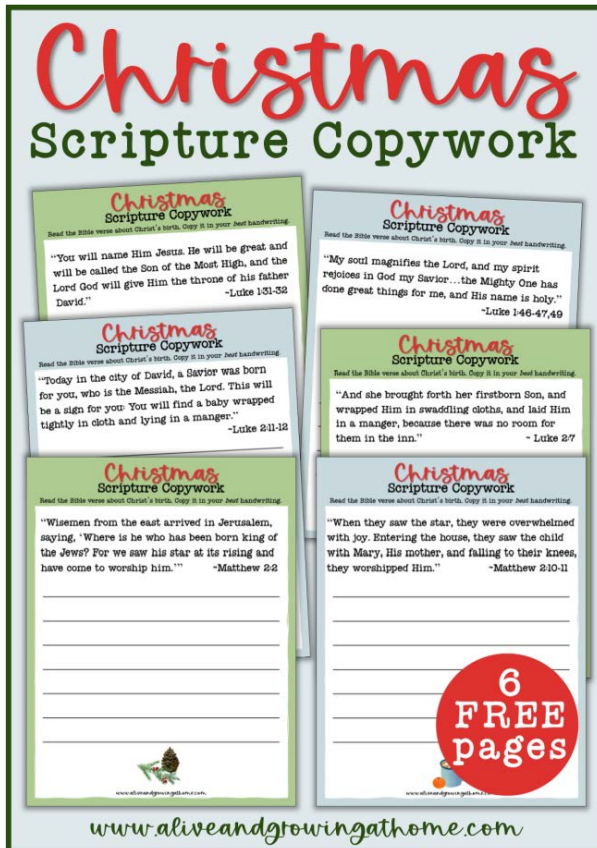


Christmas Scripture Copywork

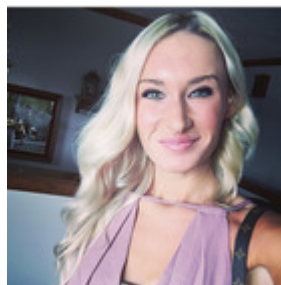
