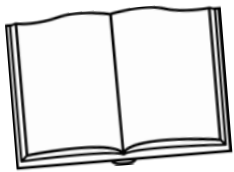

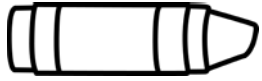
How to Use:
